Financial Aid Overview

- YingHua International School offers need-based financial aid.
- Financial aid is awarded on an annual basis. Families are required to apply and demonstrate financial need for each year of enrollment.
- If a family demonstrates a relatively stable financial situation, they can expect to receive a similar level of financial aid for the tenure of the student's enrollment.

Families applying for financial aid will need to complete an application and submit the necessary supporting documentation to FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment by March 1. Based on information parents submit in the FACTS applications, FACTS provides the school with an independent confidential assessment of a family's ability to pay for educational expenses.

Applying for Financial Aid

To apply for financial aid, please follow the steps below. Instructions and requirements can also be found online under <http://yhis.org/admissions-e/financialaid-new>

On or before February 1:

- When completing the FACTS, you may have to use estimated figures for the prior tax year. All numbers will need to be verified by final tax documents as soon as they become available and before a final financial aid package can be awarded.
- Once an online application has been completed, the following information will need to be sent to FACTS to complete the application process:
 - Copies of your most recent Federal tax forms including all supporting tax schedules.
 - Copies of your current W-2 forms for both you and your spouse.
 - Copies of supporting documentation for Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation, and TANF.
- In the case of divorced or separated parents, each retains the obligation to contribute to the education of his or her child, regardless of whether a legal agreement to do so exists. In this instance, both parents must complete a required Financial Aid application either jointly or separately. Financial aid grants will be made only after considering the financial resources of both parents. In the case of separated and/or divorced parents, no information will be given by the school to either parent regarding the other parent's financial disclosures. The assets of both parents will be considered before making any award; the assertion that one parent has disclaimed responsibility for educational expenses does not apply.
