General School Requirements	
<input type="checkbox"/> Two (2) reusable water bottles	One bottle remains in school, and one bottle travels with the student between school and home. Students will be able to refill water bottles at school.
<input type="checkbox"/> One (1) bottle of hand sanitizer	For student use at school
<input type="checkbox"/> Three (3) packs of disinfectant wipes	For classroom use.
<input type="checkbox"/> One (1) season-appropriate change of clothing	Please place everything in a clear Ziploc bag labeled with the student's name.
<input type="checkbox"/> Lunch box with reusable eating utensils	Please avoid using disposable items such as plastic forks, spoons and sandwich bags. NO glass containers.
<input type="checkbox"/> Snacks & Lunch (unless ordering from the school lunch program)	Please note that we are a nut-free school . No bars with nuts, including granola bars, are allowed.

- One (1) pair of scissors
- One (1) foot-long ruler with centimeter and inch markings
- Twelve (12) sharpened # 2 HB pencils, nine of which will be collected for the class to use
- One (1) large glue stick
- Three (3) pens: red, blue, black
- One (1) pack of 4 pads 3" x 3" Post-it notes
- One (1) black permanent marker (bold size, not fine, not chisel)
- Three (3) highlighters (of various colors)
- Four (4) erasers, three of which will be collected for the class to use
- One (1) pack of 10 washable markers
- One (1) pack of 12 colored pencils
- One (1) pack 100 3" x 5" ruled index cards (white), will be collected for the class to use
- Seven (7) **Heavy Duty 2 pocket prong PLASTIC folders**: Red (Math), Gray & Black (Chinese), Purple (Music, PHE), Yellow & Blue (English), Green (Science). Students may re-use old folders.
